

## WEDDING MUSIC GUIDELINES

Marriage is a sacrament, a visible sign of God's grace. This is the day you affirm your love and commitment not only to each other, but also to the parish community. It is not a private ceremony, but a liturgy (a work of the people) in the truest sense of the word – one that involves your families and friends. May it ring with joyful song!

Because of the solemnity of this sacrament, only <u>sacred</u>, liturgical music is acceptable for your wedding ceremony or Mass. Show tunes, pop music, secular love songs, operatic songs, etc., are **not** considered appropriate for your wedding ceremony. Save them for the reception!
